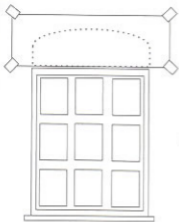
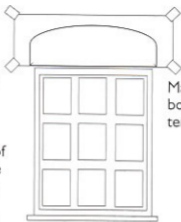


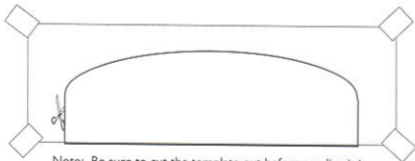
How to Make an Accurate Template



Tape Butcher paper or heavy wrapping paper over the window opening, allowing for plenty of overlap. Do not use paper that has been folded. A template should not have any folds or creases.



Make sure the bottom of your template is level.



Note: Be sure to cut the template out before sending it in.

Cut the shape from the wall. Check the template dimensions to match your measurements of the actual arch opening. Mark the shade dimensions on the template. Write the customer's name and sidemark and mark ROOM SIDE. Also label the color number. Include the template with your order form.
