Installation Guide: No-Drill Stick On Casual Cellulars

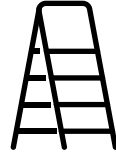

Quick pointers

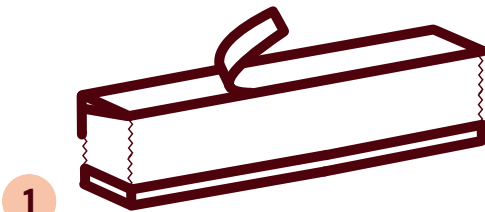
Make sure the surface is flat to ensure the strongest hold. If you've just painted, allow 2 weeks for paint to fully dry/cure before installation.

The adhesive is VERY STRONG, so you'll need to be extra sure the area is fully wiped and ready before installation.

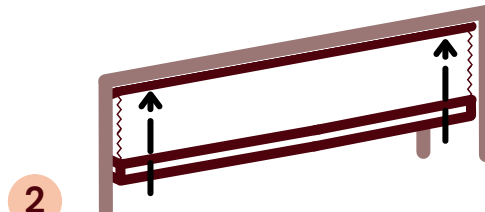


LEVEL 1 INSTALLATION

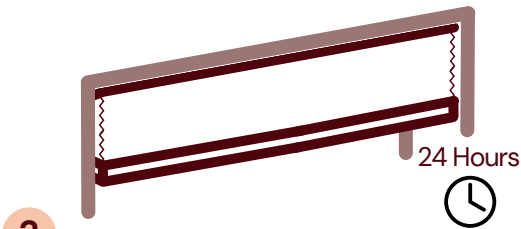
INSIDE MOUNT



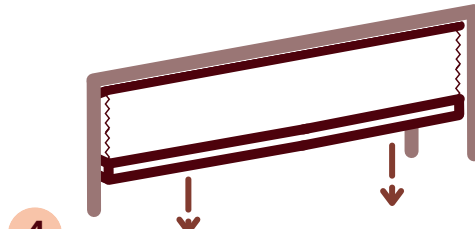
1 Apply the adhesive strip directly to the top of the shade. Only peel the adhesive backing when you're ready to install. Peel off the backing from the back of the adhesive strip.



2 Slide the shade into the opening and press the shade's headrail firmly up on the top of the window opening for about 30 seconds.



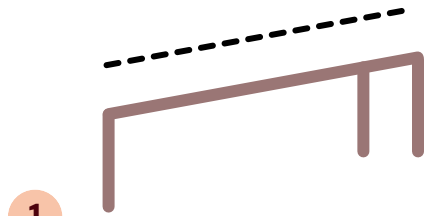
3 Please don't use the shade 24 hours for the adhesive to fully set. Once it fully sets, it can be operated as normal.



4 The shade can then be operated by raising and lowering it with the bottom rail. Please use two hands evenly spaced to keep it level.

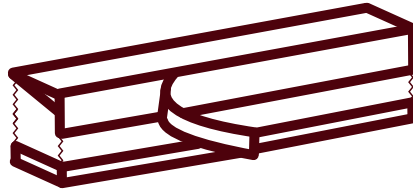
OUTSIDE MOUNT

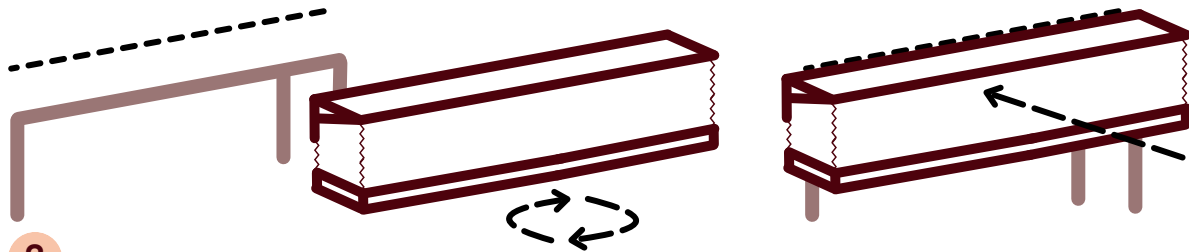
Using a pencil, make a straight line at least 1 1/8" above the window opening. If you want to ensure the product will hang and operate evenly, use a Level to make sure the line is straight.

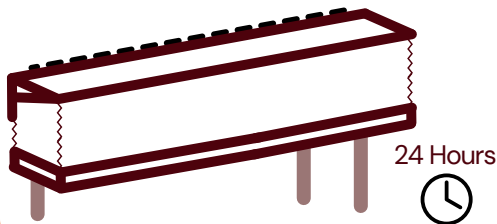
Apply the adhesive strip directly to the back of the shade. Only peel the adhesive when you're ready to install. Peel off the adhesive cover from the back of the shade's headrail.

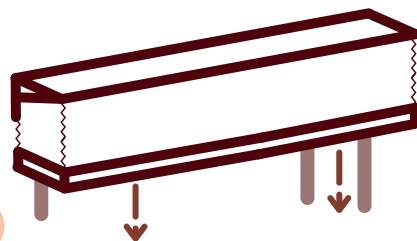
Turn the shade around and line the top of the headrail up with the mark on the wall. Press the shade's headrail firmly for about 30 seconds.

Please don't use the shade 24 hours for the adhesive to fully set.

The shade can then be operated by raising and lowering it with the bottom rail. Please use two hands evenly spaced to keep it level.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

1

For regular maintenance, use a duster or a vacuum with a brush attachment and run it over the front and back of the shade.

To spot clean stains, use a damp rag with a very mild, gentle detergent or soap. Dab at the affected spots; DO NOT RUB! Let the dampened area air dry and repeat as necessary.

All fabrics are different and some may be easier to clean than others. We recommend cleaning your shades as often as once a month.
