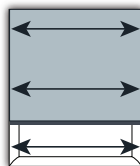
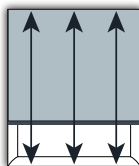
Inside mount (IB):

The shade is mounted inside to the top of the window frame.

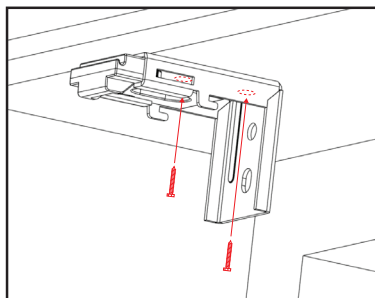
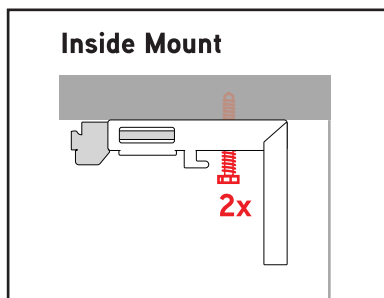
- For wallboard or plaster: Use hollow wall anchors for added support. (not included)
- For concrete, stone, brick or tile: Use an appropriate drill and appropriate anchors before fastening the screws. (not included)
- For metal surfaces: Pre-drill holes and use appropriate anchors before fastening the screws. (not included)

TROUBLE SHOOTING TIPS

Dry-Fit Bracket into Headrail Cassette: Prior to installing your shade, dry-fit the Bracket into the Headrail Cassette to verify how the bracket will snap into place.

Installing Brackets:

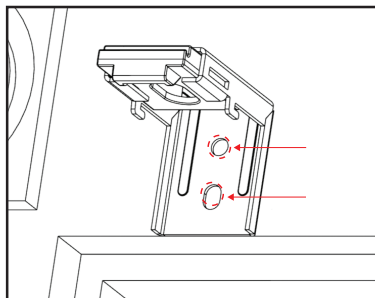
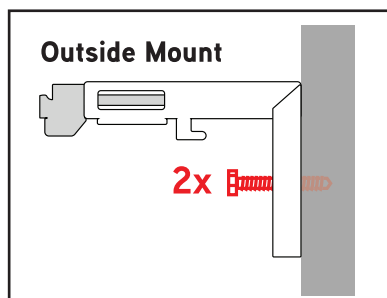
Inside mount: Use the stickers on the headrail to find the bracket center for each bracket. The bracket is able to move within the 2" area shown on the sticker.



- Hold the headrail up inside the window frame and mark center based of the provided sticker on the headrail.
- Align brackets to the marked positions and secure through two holes, ensuring that the bracket tops are aligned and level to one another. Use wall anchors for a secure hold.

Outside Mount: Outside edge of the brackets should be positioned at a minimum of 2" from the outside of the headrail cassette, note the sticker on the headrail cassette. Use wall anchors for a secure hold. Mark the position of the bracket as illustrated.

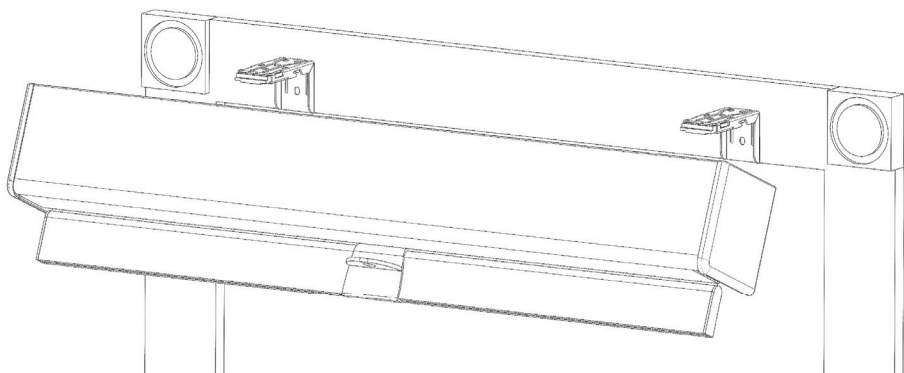
- Hold the headrail up above outside the window frame and mark center based of the provided sticker on the headrail.
- Align brackets to the marked positions and secure through two holes, ensuring that the bracket tops are aligned and level to one another. Use wall anchors for a secure hold.



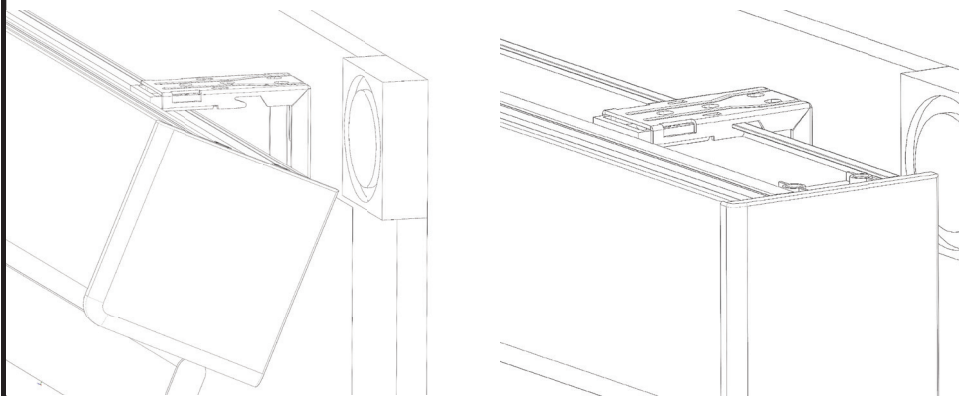
Spacer blocks (optional) will be attached to the end of each bracket. Ensure screws are long enough to secure brackets with spacer blocks. Do not use more than three spacer blocks per bracket. If installing extension brackets, do not use spacer blocks.

2 INSTALLING THE SHADE

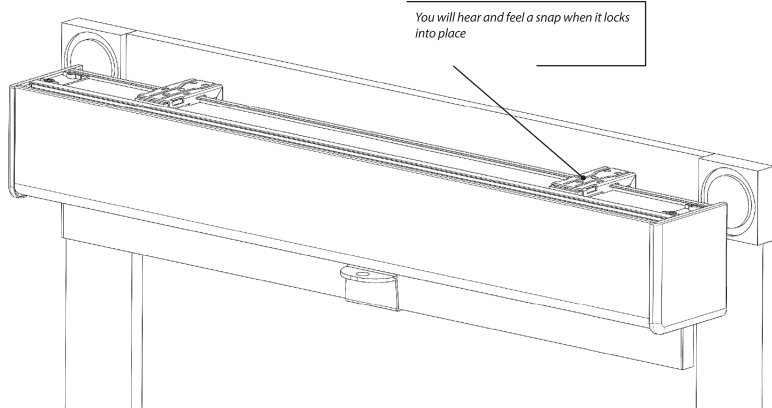
1. Lift the head rail into position.



2. Slide the headrail into the brackets and rotate it down until it snaps into place.



The top of the shade should look like the referenced image below.



OPERATING THE SHADE

- To close the shade, gently pull the bottom rail down to the desired height.
- To open shade, gently push bottom rail all the way to the headrail or to desired height.



CARE AND CLEANING

The soft, delicate feel of woven fabric with the durability of wood materials. It is made from a sturdy, woven fabric and wood slats which can be feather dusted or vacuumed on a low setting. Spots or stains can be lightly rubbed clean with a damp sponge and mild soap. To avoid discoloration of the material, we recommend against the use of chemical cleaners. The woven fabric may also be ultrasonically cleaned.

Remove The Shade

- Fully raise the shade.
- While holding the headrail, remove each wing nut from all screws on the brackets.
- If required, pull the micropleat opacity liner free from the mounting clips by releasing the latch.

Cleaning Procedures

For most fabrics, the following options are available if your shade needs cleaning.

Dust Removal

In most cases, just use a feather duster to gently dust off regularly

Vacuuming

Use a low-suction hand-held vacuum cleaner to remove dust more thoroughly

Hair Dryer

Use a hair dryer to turn on the cold air to blow away the dirt and debris between the blades.

Spot Cleaning

- Prepare a solution of warm water and a mild detergent.
- Dampen a clean cloth in the solution and wring out.
- Dab the spot with the dampened cloth until it is gone. Do not rub the fabric.
- Allow the shade to dry in the completely lowered position.

NOTE:

Window Blind Cord Strangulation Risk

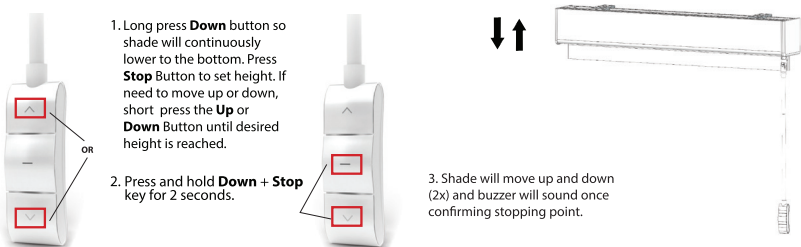

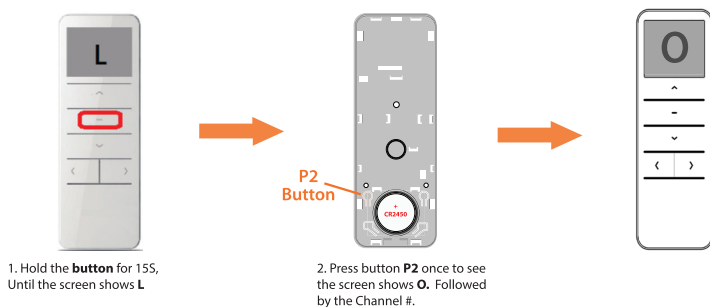
User Mode: In this mode, the shades key combination debugging function is locked to avoid mis-operation by the user.

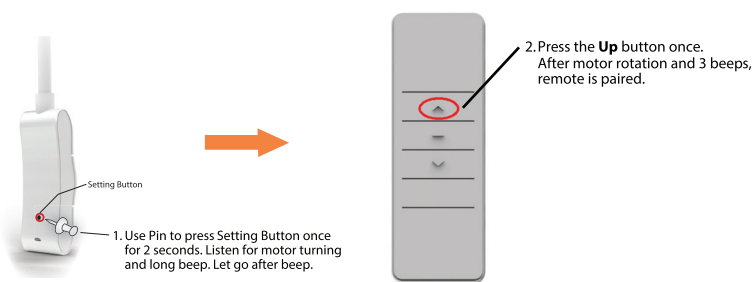

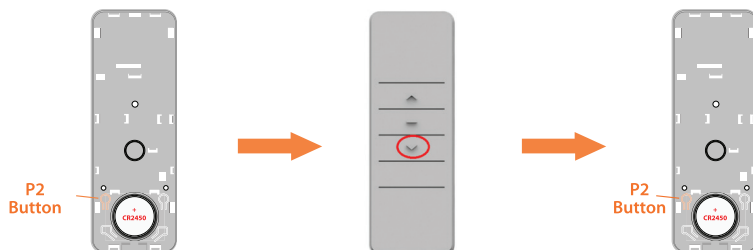


DELETING ALL REMOTE CONTROLS



1. Press the **P2 button** on the remote control once, the motor will rotate once and will beep once.
2. Press the **Stop** button on the remote control again, the motor will rotate once and will beep once.
3. Press the **P2 button** on the remote control once again, the motor will rotate once and will beep 5 times, indicating that the code has been successfully deleted

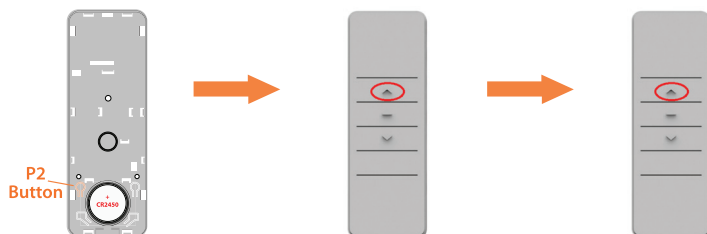
DELETING THE STOPPING POINTS



1. Press the **P2 button** on the remote control once, the motor will rotate and will beep once.
2. Press the **Down** button on the remote control once. The motor will rotate once and will beep once.
3. Press the **P2 button** on the remote control once again, the motor will rotate once and will beep 4 times, indicating that all stopping points have been deleted successfully.

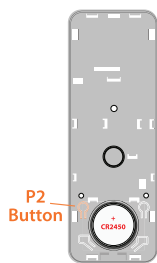
SHADE LIFTING SPEED ADJUSTMENT - INCREASE SHADE LIFTING SPEED

THERE ARE THREE SHADE SPEEDS: 34R/MIN; 28R/MIN; 20R/MIN



1. Press the **P2 button** on the remote control. The motor will rotate and will beep once.
2. Short press the **Up** button on the remote control for one second. The motor will rotate and will beep once.
3. Short press the **Up** button on the remote control for one second. The motor will rotate twice, and will beep once, and the motor speed will increase by one gear.
(If there is no rotation prompt, it means that the maximum gear has been reached)

REDUCE SHADE LIFTING SPEED



1. Short press the **P2 button** on the remote control for one second. The motor will rotate and will beep once.



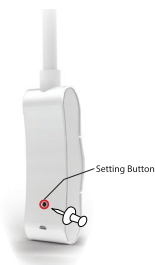
2. Short press the **Down button** on the remote control for one second. The motor will rotate and will beep once.



3. Then short press the **Down button** on the remote control for one second. The motor will rotate twice and will beep once, and the motor speed will decrease by one gear. (If there is no rotation prompt, it means that the low gear has been reached.)

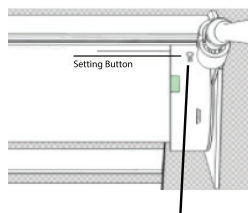
SHADE REVERSAL

USE THE MOTORIZED WAND TO SET



Using a pin, press and **hold** the setting button on the back of the motorized wand for more than 6 seconds. After the rotation prompts twice during this process, release the button and will beep 3 times; indicating that the motor direction is successfully switched.

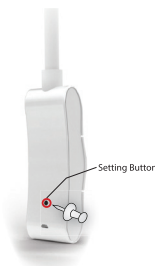
-OR-



Press and **hold** the setting button of the shade motor for more than 6 seconds. After the rotation prompts three times during this process, release the button and will beep 3 times; indicating that the motor direction is successfully switched.

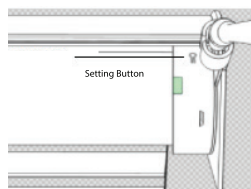
RESTORING FACTORY SETTINGS

USE THE MOTORIZED WAND TO SET



Using a pin, press and **hold** the handle setting button for more than 10 seconds; during this process, the motor beeps 4 times after rotating the prompt three times; indicating that the motor has been restored to factory settings; all previous system function settings and remote control codes have been deleted.

-OR-



Press and **hold** the shade motor setting button for more than 10 seconds; during this process, the motor beeps 4 times after the rotation prompts four times; it means that the motor has been restored to factory settings; all previous system function settings and remote control codes have been deleted.

- For concrete, stone, brick or tile: Use an appropriate drill and appropriate anchors before fastening the screws. (not included)
- For metal surfaces: Pre-drill holes and use appropriate anchors before fastening the screws. (not included)

TROUBLE SHOOTING TIPS

Dry-Fit Bracket into Headrail Cassette: Prior to installing your shade, dry-fit the Bracket into the Headrail Cassette to verify how the bracket will snap into place.

Installing Brackets:

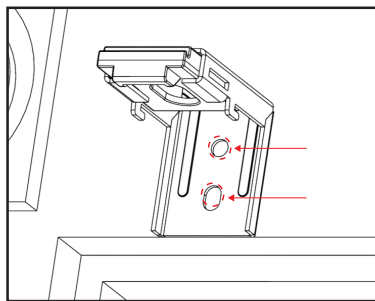
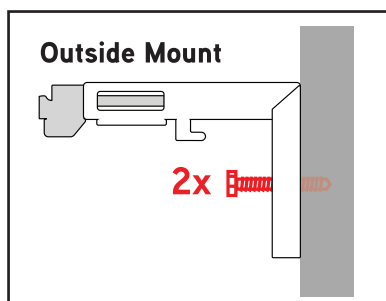
Inside mount: Use the stickers on the headrail to find the bracket center for each bracket. The bracket is able to move within the 2" area shown on the sticker.



- Hold the headrail up inside the window frame and mark center based of the provided sticker on the headrail.
- Align brackets to the marked positions and secure through two holes, ensuring that the bracket tops are aligned and level to one another. Use wall anchors for a secure hold.

Outside Mount: Outside edge of the brackets should be positioned at a minimum of 2" from the outside of the headrail cassette, note the sticker on the headrail cassette. Use wall anchors for a secure hold. Mark the position of the bracket as illustrated.

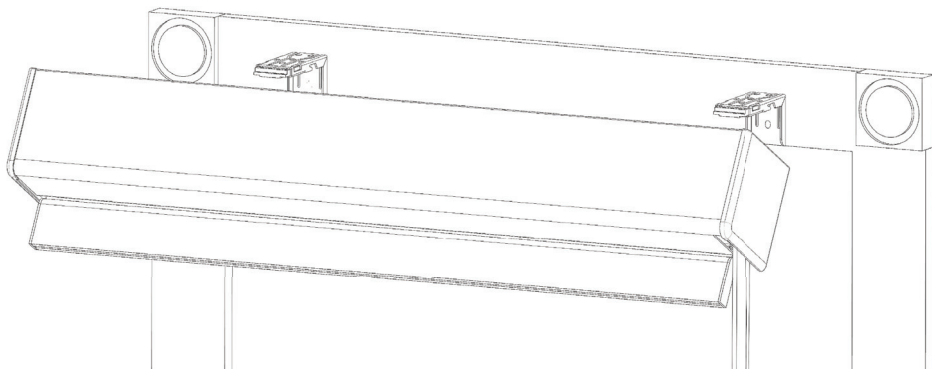
- Hold the headrail up above outside the window frame and mark center based of the provided sticker on the headrail.
- Align brackets to the marked positions and secure through two holes, ensuring that the bracket tops are aligned and level to one another. Use wall anchors for a secure hold.



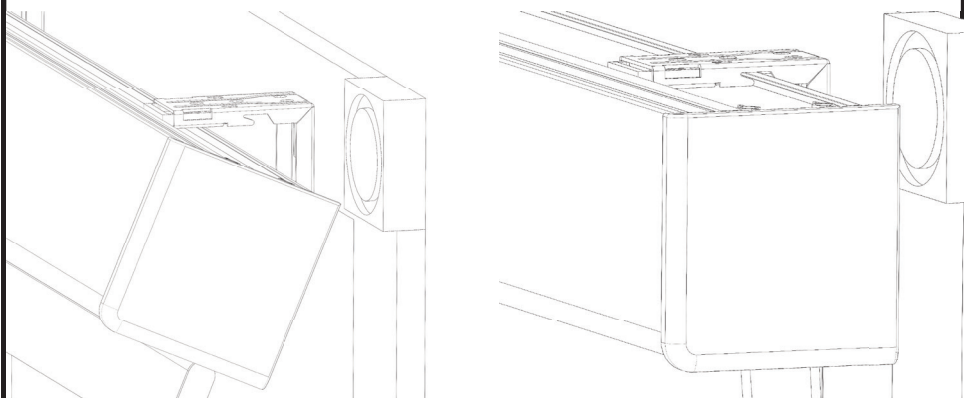
Spacer blocks (optional) will be attached to the end of each bracket. Ensure screws are long enough to secure brackets with spacer blocks. Do not use more than three spacer blocks per bracket. If installing extension brackets, do not use spacer blocks.

CARE AND CLEANING

The soft, delicate feel of woven fabric with the durability of wood materials. It is made from a sturdy, woven fabric and wood slats which can be feather dusted or vacuumed on a low setting. Spots or stains can be lightly rubbed clean with a damp sponge and mild soap. To avoid discoloration of the material, we recommend against the use of chemical cleaners. The woven fabric may also be ultrasonically cleaned.

Remove The Shade

- Fully raise the shade.
- While holding the headrail, remove each wing nut from all screws on the brackets.
- If required, pull the micropleat opacity liner free from the mounting clips by releasing the latch.

Cleaning Procedures

For most fabrics, the following options are available if your shade needs cleaning.

Dust Removal

In most cases, just use a feather duster to gently dust off regularly

Vacuuming

Use a low-suction hand-held vacuum cleaner to remove dust more thoroughly

Hair Dryer

Use a hair dryer to turn on the cold air to blow away the dirt and debris between the blades.

Spot Cleaning

- Prepare a solution of warm water and a mild detergent.
- Dampen a clean cloth in the solution and wring out.
- Dab the spot with the dampened cloth until it is gone. Do not rub the fabric.
- Allow the shade to dry in the completely lowered position.

(Products purchased prior to this date remain subject to the warranty terms in effect at the time of original purchase.)

1. Limited Warranty Coverage

Lantex USA, Inc. ("Lantex USA") warrants to the original purchaser that its blinds and shades, including, without limitation, Wood Woven Shades, Fabric Horizontal Blinds, Sheer Vertical and Horizontal Shades, Roman Shades, Zebra Shades, Cellular Shades, Aluminum Blinds, Pleated Shades, and painted or stained valances (collectively, the "Products"), shall be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal residential use and service during the warranty periods set forth herein. For purposes of this Limited Warranty, "normal residential use" shall mean ordinary indoor residential use by the original purchaser in accordance with Lantex USA's written instructions, specifications, and operating recommendations.

Coverage under this Limited Warranty applies only where:

- The Product was properly measured, installed, operated, and maintained in accordance with Lantex USA instructions and specifications;
- The Product was manufactured or assembled by Lantex USA or its authorized manufacturing partners using approved materials and components; and
- The Product has not been subjected to misuse, abuse, neglect, accident, alteration, improper installation, improper maintenance, or abnormal environmental conditions.

Residential Warranty Periods

- Hardware and mechanical components: three (3) years from date of purchase;
- Fabric materials: three (3) years from date of purchase; and
- Motorized components: five (5) years from date of purchase.

Motorized Components

Motorized Products are programmed at the factory. Lantex USA shall not be responsible for malfunctions, operational failures, or damage resulting from unauthorized programming, reprogramming, resetting, modification, tampering, or use of non-approved third-party control systems, accessories, or software. Unauthorized modifications or alterations may void warranty coverage applicable to motorized components.

Commercial Installations

For Products installed in commercial or non-residential applications, warranty coverage shall be limited to three (3) years from the original date of purchase, regardless of Product type or component. Commercial applications include, without limitation, offices, retail establishments, hospitality venues, schools, medical facilities, rental properties, and multi-unit common areas.

2. Warranty Eligibility and Limitations
