Select Blinds Child Safety Checklist



Bedroom

- 1 ☐ All window coverings should be cordless or have cord cleats installed so the cords are out of the reach of children.
- 2 ☐ Move cribs, beds, chairs, and other furniture away from windows.
- 3 ☐ Install a window guard in all second-story rooms.

Living Area

- 4 ☐ Secure furniture and TVs to the walls.
- 5 ☐ Cover all electrical outlets, even those you think are out of reach.
- 6 ☐ Install safety gates at the top and bottom of all stairs.

Kitchen/bathroom

- 7 ☐ Add safety latches to all doors and drawers.
- 8 ☐ Put cleaning supplies, medications, and other toxic items in a locked cabinet that's out of reach.
- 9 ☐ Use stove knob guards to make sure they're temporarily inoperable.
